Notes:

Per the Ontario Roadmap to Reopen, **indoor** social gathering limits in Step 3 are not to exceed twenty five (25) people. In order to keep indoor social gathering safe in Sunbeam's group home programs, the "max visitors per resident" remains at 2, and we will limit the number of residents receiving indoor visits at any given time to no more than 1.

Requests for exceptions will be considered. Please contact the applicable Group Home Supervisor with your request.

Per the Ontario Roadmap to Reopen, **outdoor** social gathering limits under Step 3 are not to exceed 100 people.

In order to keep outdoor social gathering safe in Sunbeam's group home programs, the "max visitors per resident" should not exceed 6, and we will limit the number of residents receiving visitors in the same outdoor/yard space at any given time to no more than 1.

Requests for exceptions will be considered. Please contact the applicable Group Home Supervisor with your request.

* Essential visits are strongly recommended to be scheduled in advance, in order to manage capacity limits in the homes at all times. Staff reserve the right to delay or defer unscheduled essential visits based on capacity limits and other operational requirements.

*** Rapid Antigen Test:**

Host to be tested upon pickup.

Individual to be tested upon return, on a best efforts / as tolerated basis.

If rapid test yields a positive indicator, Public Health protocols are immediately followed.

**** Isolation protocol for persons-served:**

Is always on a best efforts / as tolerated basis;

Often will include enhanced monitoring.

Guidance is:

If fully vaccinated, isolate until PCR test results known, appropriate protocols are then followed.

If not fully vaccinated, PCR testing and/or rapid testing are followed and isolation for 10 days is expected.

Return from the family home may be considered differently from return from hospital; families will be contacted accordingly.
