Includes: Van Rides, Walks, Outings

Use the following chart to review safety measures for each type of community outing, and what changes during an outbreak.

Activity	Routine Operations	Outbreak
Van Rides	<p>Permitted for all persons-served.</p> <p>No limit to number of persons-served in the vehicle who are from the same group home.</p> <p>Persons-served who can tolerate the use of masks should be encouraged to do so while in the vehicle.</p> <p>Open windows of vehicle to promote optimal ventilation.</p> <p>Van cleaning should occur as per guidelines following each use.</p>	<p>Permitted for persons-served who are not symptomatic or COVID-19 positive.</p> <p>Max limit of 1 person-served in vehicle at a time.</p>
Neighbourhood Walks	<p>Permitted for all persons-served.</p> <p>Preference is to avoid crowded or highly populated routes/trails.</p>	<p>Permitted for persons-served who are not symptomatic or COVID-19 positive</p> <p><u>Conditions:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remain on Sunbeam property. • Short walks off-property permitted only in the immediate neighbourhood, when there is not high pedestrian traffic.
Community Outings	<p>Permitted for all persons-served.</p> <p>Preference to avoid crowded settings. Choose times to visit when the location is least busy.</p>	<p>Suspended during outbreak.</p>

Safety Measures & Use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Persons-served will be actively screened before leaving and upon re-entry to the group home using our *Person-Served COVID-19 Screening* form and tracking log

Staff member remains masked at all times. Bring portable hand sanitizer for the drive/outing. Hand hygiene should be practiced frequently and well by both staff and the person-served (assisted).
